Program Overview

This program provides couples with an all-inclusive and comprehensive appreciation and knowledge of the Sacrament of Matrimony. *One in Christ* presents both the sacramental theology and the practical "tools" of Christian Marriage so the couples reach an understanding of how marriage is a participation of the life of Heaven and what that means for their lives together here on Earth.

The course presents the truth, beauty, and goodness of marriage and family life. This approach is very appealing to today's couples, assaulted as they are by much secular negativity about marriage. Our goal is not just to present information on marriage, but rather to begin with a basic catechesis on the Catholic Faith and interweave it throughout the seminar. As a result, it becomes a catechesis reinvigorating the couple's faith life within the context of marriage preparation. The central goal of the course is to show how God and His grace are the remedies and the quintessential means to a happy, healthy, hold, and lasting marriage.

Each session includes a presentation (optionally followed by a short testimonial video), discussion questions for the couple, and prayer. There are also exercises throughout the presentations that help the couple identify at least two things they learned from each presentation. Optional DVD testimonies can help add to the element of witness during each session. Each session is designed to take 2 hours to complete.
