# Together in God's Love

#### **Program Overview**

Together in God's Love covers all of the key areas of the 2009 USCCB pastoral letter entitled, "Marriage: Love and Life in the Divine Plan", and includes key ideas from the Theology of the Body, and a focus on The Trinity, with current and relevant scientific research on healthy marriages.

This program combines cultural competency, psychological research, and Catholic theology as couples prepare to become one in Christ through holy matrimony. Using practical and active learning techniques, the program focuses on key aspects of marriage – Faith, Communication, Sexuality, and Stewardship – to express marriage as a communion of persons, just as the Holy Trinity is a communion of persons. It is attentive to various learning styles as well as cultural diversity through the use of language, games, role playing, and self-assessments.

All sessions begin with prayer and a self-assessment exercise. Every session also includes questions for the couple to discuss and time for reflection and concludes with prayer. Optional DVD testimonies can help add to the element of witness during each session. Each session is designed to take 2 hours to complete.
